



Royal St. Lawrence Yacht Club Physical Distancing and Sanitation Directive Guest policy

Club Guest Policy Effective Summer 2020

This Directive applies to members who wish to bring guests to the Club and is issued based on requirements issued by the government of Quebec and Voile Québec to minimize the risk associated with COVID-19. **It is the responsibility of every member who brings a guest to the Club in accordance with this directive to inform the guest of these rules and ensure that all guests abide by them.**

Use of pool and tennis courts	Only immediate family (mother, father, children and grandchildren) may accompany a member and use the pool or tennis courts. Note that reservations are required and must identify guests.
Clubhouse/Restaurant	Only immediate family (mother, father, children and grandchildren) may be invited to the Clubhouse and restaurant. In accordance with government requirements everyone must wear a face covering in all indoor spaces at the Club. Note that for the moment, the Clubhouse is only open to use the bathrooms and all meals are taken on the lawn and patio. The Club cannot accommodate groups due to the social distancing requirements at the tables.
Members' boats	Members may invite guests to their boats. Guests must be escorted from the property entrance to the boat and vice versa. The number of guests must enable the owner to respect distancing rules while on board.
Service pier	The service pier is open for the purchase of fuel and for pump-outs. Non-member visitors who come to the Club by boat will be provided with fuel and pump-out services but cannot access the rest of the property and cannot spend any leisure time nor spend the night at the service pier, except in the event of an emergency and by specific permission from Club management.

Members are reminded that all COVID-19 directives are posted on the Club web site and are encouraged to check the site for updates and information on activities around the Club.
