

## Haul-out, Fall 2020, Group 1

As previously announced, we will start taking the boats out of the water during the week of September 14, 2020.

This year, we must proceed in such a way to avoid possible Covid resurgence later in the fall. We will also use the extra time to work in the harbor, accomplishing some of the work put aside in the spring when we concentrated our efforts on putting the boats in the water.

Here are some quick reminders:

1. You cannot leave your boats plugged in this winter, it is a fire safety precaution;
2. You cannot tie your shrink wrap or other coverings to the jack stands holding your boat.

Lastly, as you probably know, all our docks are now occupied. We recommend you verify availability of docks going forward, were you to change boats, especially for one of a bigger dimension.
