

Pool Rules

1. Upon arriving at the pool, please sign the register placed at your disposal near the entrance. Signing in is compulsory if you intend to use the pool.
2. Please follow our pool staff's instructions, as their aim is to ensure your safety:
 - a. Pool staff has the authority to ensure compliance with the present pool rules.
 - b. Pool staff has the authority to deny anyone access to the pool area or to ask anyone to leave the pool area.
 - c. Pool staff has the authority to close the pool.
 - d. Please see the inclement weather policy on our website for further pool closure notices
3. Please pay attention and abide to the notices posted in the pool area. They are designed to keep you safe.
4. If you have guests, please remain with them at the pool and make sure they know and follow the pool rules.
5. Shower with soap before swimming. Showers and soap are at your disposal inside the changing room and outside near the promenade.
6. You must wear a bathing suit to swim.
7. Children less than 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult. This adult must always be ready to enter the pool and therefore must wear a bathing suit.
 - a. Children under 6 years of age and any children using an inflated buoyancy device must be accompanied and supervised by an adult who is in the pool.
 - b. No child may use the wading pool without being accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult member.
8. Babies and diaper wearing toddlers must wear a clean and leak proof swim diaper in the pool.
9. If you are suffering from a contagious disease, an infection, and specifically from a gastro-enteritis, or if you have an open sore or wound, please refrain from using the pool.
10. Food and beverages are available at the pool from Café Marler which is governed by the Club's liquor and restaurant licenses. To maintain this service, bringing your own food or beverages, other than water, to the pool is prohibited.
11. No food or drink is allowed in the pool or wading pool and on the reserved promenade around the pool.
12. No glass container of any kind is allowed anywhere in the pool area.
13. Diving is prohibited in the shallow portion of the pool and, whenever the case, in the part of the pool reserved for swimming laps.
14. Rough playing, shoving, and aggressive behavior is prohibited anywhere in the pool area.
15. Please walk, do not run, anywhere on the promenade of the pool and in the adjoining buildings.
16. Please free pool-side chairs and return your trays to Café Marler when you leave the pool area.
17. Smoking is prohibited anywhere in the pool area.
18. Pets are not allowed anywhere in the pool area.
19. The present rules may be amended from time to time, in particular to ensure compliance with the applicable legislation.

Definitions for the purpose of the present rules:

- "pool" includes the main basin and the wading basin
- "pool area" includes all the installations, buildings, basins, structures within the fenced in perimeter of the pool, including the terrace outside the back entrance of Café Marler;
- "reserved promenade" includes a width of no less than 1.5 meters around the main basin.
- "pool staff" includes lifeguards and assistant lifeguards.
