



## **RStLYC TENNIS REGULATIONS 2021**

### **Opening hours**

- The 3 courts are open every day from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., including public holidays.
- Daily maintenance is done before 9 am.

### **Court usage**

- It is necessary to wait until the courts are sufficiently dry before playing.
- Out of respect for the next players, exiting players should leave the court in good condition. A broom, a drag mat and a line brush are available for courts 1, 2 and 3.
- Lights can be turned on in the evening, however the last players must turn them off before leaving.

### **Reservations**

- Reservations are required through the online Court Reserve tool. Reservations are made for a period of one (1) hour for singles play and two (2) hours for doubles play.
- Reservations may be scheduled up to a week in advance.
- Cancelled reservations must be done through the Court Reserve tool.
- All players, including guests, (during COVID only immediate family) must be listed on the reservation. If the players are not present within 15 minutes after the scheduled start of the game time, your allocated time slot will be redistributed and a reservation cancellation will need to be implemented.
- Players can continue to play if the court is not already reserved.

### **Ball machine**

- A "Ball-throwing" machine is available on court no.3 (near the pool).
- A reservation through Court Reserve must be made to use it.
- The key is available at the office during normal hours or when the office is closed, at the bar. Instructions accompany the key.

### **Juniors**

Players 16 and under may play but must be accompanied by an adult member.

### **Dress code**

- Appropriate tennis clothing is required.
- Tennis shoes compatible with playing on a clay court surface are mandatory. Jogging shoes or shoes with inadequate soles that can damage the court, are prohibited.

### **Access to the courts**

Players must enter and leave courts 1 and 2 through their respective doors to avoid disturbing a game in progress.

### **Guests (during COVID, only immediate family)**

- A member can invite up to three people to complete a doubles play on one court.
- Each guest can play a maximum of 5 times per year.

### **N.B.**

Rules are also available for the various tournaments.

A pro is available for group and individual lessons.
