3 Eligibility

3.7 Participants MUST identify to the Race Committee boat prior to starting which handicap they will be sailing under.

10 The course

Course to be finalized at the skipper's meeting:

Course #1

- 1) Start between the Committee Boat and an orange race mark in the vicinity of AD 15
- 2) AD 18 (red mark at the gut) to starboard
- 3) AD 28 to Port
- 4) Respect the Windmill Point Channel (AE 16 to AE 2)
- 5) A 38 to starboard
- 6) BEA B to port
- 7) Alternate finish between the RC Boat and an orange race mark in the vicinity of AC 59
- 8) LAC B to port
- 9) Respect the "Z" Channel AD 1 to DOR A
- 10) Finish between the Committee Boat and an orange race mark in the vicinity of AS 15

Course #2

- 1) Start between the Committee Boat and an orange race mark in the vicinity of AC 59 (just before entering the main seaway)
- 2) BEA B to port (near Beauharnois locks)
- 3) A 38 to port
- 4) Respect the Windmill Point Channel (AE 2 to AE 16)
- 5) AD 28 to starboard
- 6) AD 18 (red mark at gut) to port
- 7) AD 15 to starboard
- 8) Finish between the Committee Boat and an orange race mark in the vicinity of AS 15

16 Time Limits

16.2 There is a six hour time limit for the first boat to cross the finish line. Boats failing to finish within 120 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF. This changes RRS rule 35
