Rules

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)**, wherein the sailing instructions are the RStLYC Standing Sailing Instructions (SSI) and any addenda thereto with respect to this event posted on the Official Notice Board.

Eligibility and Entry

Entries must meet eligibility of a Club-Racing GNS Event. The Windmill Point Shield is restricted to single-hull keelboats of the Cruising Class. Cruising Class yachts are defined as a yacht with a head and sleeping accommodations. All boats must have a valid SLVYRA handicap. Competitors can race under either a White Sail PHRF handicap or spinnakers can be used with a Spinnaker PHRF handicap.

Schedule

There is one race scheduled. The first signal will be at 1830 hours.

- 1.) There is one start for all boats
- 2.) The course will be one windward and one leeward to finish, any changes will be written on a bulletin board located on the race committee boat.
- 3.) Competitors shall be scored under the handicap they normally sail under. Example: "a Whitesail boat will be scored under a Whitesail handicap". Competitors may request this be changed by communicating with the PRO aboard the race committee boat Beaver.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the RStLYC Annual Prize Giving Ceremony in November.
