GOOD NEIGHBOURS SERIES

- ▶ Racers from the three participating clubs will be considered members for eligibility purposes
 - ▶ Crew vouchers must be purchased for non-member crew
 - ▶ GNS races are broken up into 7 mini-series, allowing for 7 separate titles and pennants to be won over the summer, and include:

- ▶ Warm-up races on Tuesday May 14 and Thursday May 16
 - ▶ 3 separate blocs for Tuesdays:
 - ▶ 5 races from May 21 to June 18
 - ▶ 5 races from June 25 to July 23
 - ▶ 5 races from July 30 to August 27
 - ▶ 3 separate blocs for Thursdays:
 - ▶ 5 races from May 23 to June 20
 - ▶ 5 races from June 27 to July 25
 - ▶ 5 races from August 1 to August 29
 - ▶ 1 final block on Sundays:
 - ▶ 3 races on Sunday September 8
 - ▶ 3 races on Sunday September 15
 - ▶ 3 races on Sunday September 22

Start/Finish



- ▶ In GNS, PHRF 1 White Sail boats will start at the same time as PHRF 1 boats with spinnakers, but must indicate their WS status by flying a white indicator pennant.
- ▶ GNS races will be set with an objective of not being less than 1 hour each, and up to 2 hours, daylight permitting.
- ▶ All fleets to do 3 laps with 3 different upwind leg length. First mark at 0,5NM, second at 0,8 to 1,0 NM and farthest mark at 1,0 to 1,2 NM.
- ▶ Unless stated otherwise by the committee boat Race Officer, all fleets to do 3 laps or triangles with 3 different race marks all in line to windward.
 - ▶ First windward mark at 0,5NM for class 3 and 4 (yellow mark)
 - ▶ second at 0,8 to 1,0 NM for class 2 and 5 (orange mark)
 - ▶ farthest mark for classes 0, and 1 at 1,0 to 1,2 NM. (yellow mark)

IMPORTANT ITEMS OF THE NEW SLVYRA SITE

1. If it is your first year racing, make sure you have a PHRF handicap (by using the Handicap tab at the top of the page)
2. You must register to be scored (register to GNS by using the green button in the middle of the page) It takes 2 minutes...
3. The official Notice of Race and Sailing instructions are posted on the GNS page (blue button at the top on left and right side of the page)
4. You must use the site for protests, result enquiries or jury questions (3 white buttons on the left side of the page)
5. All results will be posted on the website (blue button at the top of the page)
6. Mobile Q-codes can be found in a document on the official notice board (red button on the left of the page)

If you are a PHRF I boat and may not be using a spinnaker on some nights, one registration is enough. In order to be scored with the non-spinnaker handicap you will need to fly a white burgee from your backstay.

Regatta officials are using a web-based program to assist with the management of this regatta. It provides electronic forms for such actions as scoring inquiries, protests, equipment substitutions, etc. And it provides for electronic communication with competitors if competitors have provided an email and/or telephone number accepting SMS. Competitors will be notified electronically of protest time limits, confirmation of a protest filing, scheduled hearing times, etc. This electronic system allows competitors to move freely about the event and remain in contact with relevant officials. And all competitors have electronic access to the scoring inquiries, jury decisions, etc.*

FRIDAY FUN RACES

- ▶ A great opportunity to have less-experienced sailors learn to compete, in a flexible, friendly environment
 - ▶ White sail only
 - ▶ Triangular courses with pursuit style race for the first half of the season
 - ▶ Special evenings at participating clubs to permit interclub mingling after the race
 - ▶ Everyone is invited, experienced racers available to coach less experienced sailors.

- ▶ Friday May 24 Information seminar to explain the philosophy and basic rules.
 - ▶ Fun first,
 - ▶ Learning second,
 - ▶ Meeting new friends for the Friday Fun season .
- ▶ This series will be broken up into 2 mini-series, allowing for 2 different Friday Fun pennants to be won over the summer, as follows:
 - ▶ 7 races from May 31 to July 12:
The first series will be composed of pursuit races where each boat starts with fewer around; theoretically, everyone should finish at the same time.
 - ▶ 7 races from July 19 to August 30:
The second series will have waves of starts of a maximum of 5 boats with comparative speeds evaluated from participation in prior races.

- ▶ Contrary to GNS where only the boat's performance is taken into account, the handicap system used will allow all boats AND crew to have equal opportunity to win, based on past performances.
- ▶ The system is comparable to a golf handicap where players of different levels can compete using a handicap based on past performance, permitting all to have a fair chance of winning
- ▶ All communications from the RC boat to sailors will be on VHF channel 77 to help less experienced boaters countdown to their start time, and for other information.
- ▶ More experienced sailors (of all ages) will be available to assist skippers who would like to have a coach to guide them on basic sail trimming and racing tactics for Friday Fun races.
- ▶ A special Skipper's meeting will be held for the Fun Races to ensure that all sailors have basic knowledge of sailing rules.

- ▶ There will be 2 National/international regattas hosted by the club this year
 - ▶ Lightning Pan American qualifier June 30 – July 2
 - ▶ Laser 28 North Americans September 21
